



Temporary Practicing License-working under supervision applicants may be:

- IEMLT CSMLS certified no Canadian MLT work experience; or
- IEMLT CSMLS certification exam eligible; or
- IEMLT CSMLS certification exam written and awaiting results; or
- New Graduate Certified-Canadian accredited MLT education program

Applicant Document Checklist

- Provide evidence of eligibility to work in Canada** (one of the following)
 - Canadian Citizenship- passport or birth certificate; or
 - Permanent resident- PR card; or
 - authorization under Immigration and Refugee Protection Act- work Visa/Permit
- Provide evidence of general requirements for membership**
 - Evidence of Language requirement- [language requirement](#) ; and
 - Evidence of [good character](#)- criminal record & vulnerable sector check; and
 - Submit acceptable [photo identification](#)
- Provide evidence of education**
 - Degree/Diploma from a Canadian Accredited MLT Education program; or
 - Completed CSMLS Prior Learning Assessment (PLA) Technical Report
- Provide evidence of Certification**
 - CSMLS exam registration confirmation

Note: you must provide exam results to SSMLT as soon as they are available.
- Provide evidence of currency of MLT Practice- if applicable:(Evidence not available: Refer to [SSMLT Re-entry to Practice Policy](#))**
 - Evidence of Continuing Professional Education within the previous 5 years- transcripts or certificate of attendance;
 - and
 - Evidence of MLT Practice Hours within the previous 5 years – employer or regulator validated MLT practice hours
 - Note: New graduates from Canadian Accredited MLT program have 5 years following graduation to submit evidence of Continuing Professional Education and Practice Hours
